



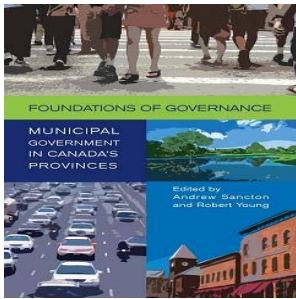
Foundations of Governance: Municipal Government in Canada's Provinces
